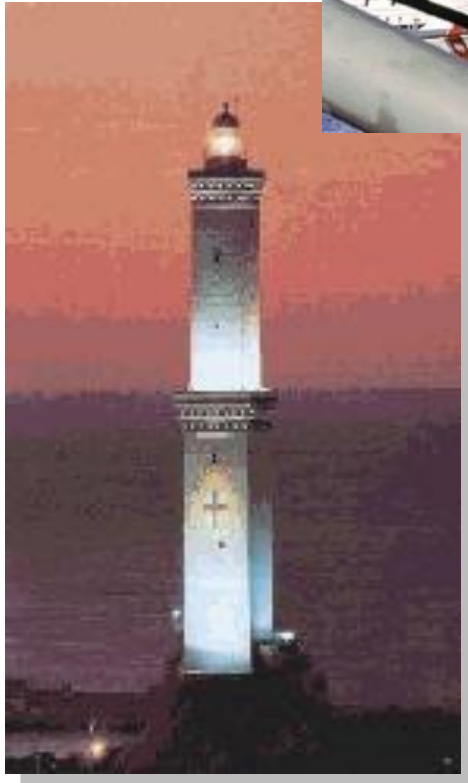


UNIGE: PAST AND PRESENT

- ❑ Established in 1481 (37th among universities in continuous operation)
- ❑ Faculty: 1260 members (37% of them are female)
- ❑ Four campuses: Genova, La Spezia, Savona, Imperia
- ❑ Five Schools (natural sciences, medical sciences, engineering and architecture, social sciences, humanities)
- ❑ 124 Bachelor and Master courses
- ❑ 28 Ph.D. courses and 80 postgraduate courses

Genoa

- Genoa (Genova in Italian, Zena in Genoese) is a city and a seaport in northern Italy, capital of Liguria and the Main port servicing the islands of Corsica and Sardinia. It has a population of approx. 700,000 inhabitants and was the European Capital of Culture 2004.

- Genoa stretches from east to west over a distance of more than 15 km, but North (Ligurian Apennines abutments) to the south (Mediterranean Sea) in less than 3 km, according to local topography, between mountains and sea. The city developed around the old port, a former semi-circular bay, which today houses a naval museum and a large public aquarium

- In the center is Piazza Ferrari, which is located near the Opera and the Doge's Palace. Here you can visit the house where they say that they were born to Christopher Columbus.

Over Street Nuova (now Via Garibaldi), in the old town, is held Palazzo Rosso (museum), Palazzo Bianco, Palazzo Grimaldi and Palazzo Reale, art college, Musei di Strada Nuova and the Palazzo del Principe.

Other tourist attractions: Cattedrale di San Lorenzo, the Old Port (Porto Antico), transformed into a mall, the famous cemetery Staglieno's known for its monuments and statues. Museo d'Arte Orientale has one of the largest collections of Oriental art in Europe.

Outside the old city, in Genova can visit the aquarium and in the vicinity of the beautiful and picturesque Boccadasse.

UNIGE: STUDENTS

- ❑ More than 31.500 students enrolled in Bachelor and Master courses
 - ❑ 56% of them are female
 - ❑ Nearly 3.000 of them (❑9%) are international students
- ❑ Nearly 3.300 students enrolled in Ph.D. and other postgraduate courses
- ❑ More than 1.200 Erasmus exchanges each year (750 outgoing and 450 incoming students)



International Relations @ Unige

- 500 Erasmus+ agreements
- 180 academic cooperation agreements in more than 60 countries
- 11 Master Science courses entirely taught in English
- Nearly 13 double degree courses
- An increasing number of courses (more than 20) teaches some subjects in English
- Mobility agreements for students, faculties and staff on all continents
- 9% of international students and 1.300+ exchange students per year (not only Erasmus)



Unige ranked third among big Italian universities (20-40.000 students) for internationalization (Censis)



UNIGE: RESEARCH

- ❑ 22 Departments and 2 Excellence Centers
- ❑ Nearly 28 MEuro of research income per year
 - ❑ Nearly 50% from industry and commerce
- ❑ 37 EC-H2020 projects
 - ❑ 6 projects coordinated by Unige
- ❑ 1 ERC – Starting Grant; 1 ERC – Advanced Grant
- ❑ 40 academic spin-off companies
- ❑ Ranked in world top 2% universities by the main rankings societies (average rank position: 360)
